In the light of Israelâ??s conquest of the Promised Land under Joshua, however, his actions find context: through David God was bringing judgment on their sworn enemies. Both men were in dangerous territoryâ??with one distinctive difference. David was learning the ways of God and Saul was turning away from God.

Psalm 17 shows a deeper understanding of Godâ??s character: God saves those who do the right thing.
