Most of us are very independent in how we live our lives. We plan our days and pursue our goals based on what's important to us . . . and it never occurs to us that there's any other way to live. James pointed out the foolishness of this kind of thinking when he said, "No one knows what tomorrow holds." We can plan our days, but we know that our plans are subject to change without notice.

God gives us an alternative to this foolishly independent way of life. He asks us to start each day with the question, "What does God will for my day?" He asks us to plan our lives so we can pursue his goals. People who train their hearts to seek first the kingdom of God will find that God has made divine appointments for them—opportunities to join him in what HE has planned for the day.
