The book of Acts flows out of Lukeâ??s gospel like a masterful sequel, shifting from Jesusâ?? life, death, and resurrection in his first volume to the actions of the apostles and church in volume 2.

Pentecost means the â??50th dayâ?• after the Jewish Passover. It marks Israelâ??s harvest celebration commemorating the Sinai covenant (Gen. 23:16a). A few weeks after Jesusâ?? death, resurrection, and ascension, the events of Pentecost seemed orderly enough at first: Jesusâ?? followers were all together (Acts 2:1). Then Lukeâ??s orderliness seemed to get out of hand: Violent winds erupted and something like â??tongues of fireâ?• rested on each of the disciples, empowering them to speak in languages that were native to Jews visiting Jerusalem from other Mediterranean lands.

Through this apparent chaos, God brought such clear order that no translator was needed. Despite the chaotic flow of todayâ??s busyness, may we listen for the Spirit to speak so clearly that no other translator is necessary.
