John 12:20-36

Jesus warned his followers that his physical presence would not continue. We read in John 12:20-36 about some Greeks who requested Philip to set up a meeting for them with Jesus. Was their request urgent? Did Philip think, â??I have to hurry,â?• as he went to Andrew about the request? Did Philip and Andrew say, â??This is urgent, we have to go immediately to Jesusâ?•? Jesus certainly expressed urgency, â??Believe in the light while you have the light, so that you may become children of lightâ?• (John 12:36). Whether others sensed time was limited or not, Jesus did. He said, â??It was for this very reason I came to this hour,â?• and â??Now is the timeâ?• (John 12:27, 31).
