Psalm 51:1-4, 10-19

Consider the words of King David as he asked God to cleanse him from his unrighteousness after he had committed adultery with Bathsheba. Allow Psalm 51 to wash over you in complete surrender to the God who heals and makes us whole again. “Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions” (v. 1).
