Jeremiah 30:12-24

“And you will be my people and I will be your God.” Our identity could not be more clear. God himself has given us our primary identity: we belong to God. As God calls us his, he declares to us that He is God, our God. Our relationship with God is also made clear. God is compassion: he restores, heals his people, and makes all things new and right again.
