Hebrews 4:8-16

In verse 12, â??Wordâ?• is translated from the Greek word *logos*. In Greek, it is the same word that is utilized in John 1:14, â??The Word became flesh.â?• In John, it refers to Christ, the living, incarnate, Son of God, Jesus. In Hebrews, we see it referencing the Word of God, as in the written scriptures.

In both instances it is the active presence of God to instruct us, teach us, and bring about transformation in our lives. In the gospel accounts, this is exactly what Jesus did.
