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1 Corinthians 15:51-58

However, what I return to time and time again is how God does what He says He will do. I can trust in the second coming of Christ with the same conviction as I do the first coming.

We who have died with Christ, live with Christ, and this is the type of life we are promised in the here and now. A life free of the sting and victory of death.
